

WIOA Federal Agency Collaboration

The U.S. Departments of Labor (DOL), Education (ED), and Health and Human Services (HHS) work collaboratively to provide guidance and technical assistance to support the workforce development system and employers. DOL and ED issue joint policy guidance to stakeholders in each agency's format. For example, the Employment and Training Administration within DOL issues policy guidance as a Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL), whereas the Rehabilitation Services Administration within ED issues policy guidance as a Technical Assistance Circular (TAC) and the Office of Career, Technical and Adult Education within ED issues policy guidance as a Program Memorandum (PM). Despite the format, the guidance is the same, as developed and reviewed jointly.

This at-a-glance document provides links to some of the jointly developed policy guidance and technical assistance products. These resources are intended to assist States and local areas in successfully implementing the integrated service delivery system envisioned by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA).
